


Progress scores are centred around 0, with most schools within the range of -5 to +5.

 A positive score means pupils in this school on average do better at KS2 as those with similar
- A positive score means pupils in this school on average do bottor at receive and the second prior attainment nationally.

 A negative score means pupils in this school on average do worse at KS2 as those with similar
- prior attainment nationally.

A negative score does not mean that pupils did not make any progress, rather it means they made less progress than other pupils nationally with similar starting points.
