




Reading every day: the power of 1:1 reading

The expectation is that every child reads at home (or is read to by an adult) every day.

Where it is such a key life skill, we feel this sits at the very top of our home learning priorities.

Reading 'High 5'

- Bring your reading record in every day.
- An adult will check these weekly.
- Once you have read five times (this does not have to be in the same week and weekends can be included) an adult will tick the 'High 5' reading chart and you will be given a pom pom for our class jar!
- When the jar is full of pom poms, our class will get time to celebrate our success together with a reading raffle activity!









Home Learning: activities in addition to reading

Daily Reading	5x 10min sessions a week
Doodle Maths	3x 10min sessions a week
Spellings [Year 2 only: from the Spring Term onwards]	Around 10 minutes a week via Spelling Shed
'Times Tables Rockstars' [Year 2 only: from the Spring Term onwards]	3x 10min sessions a week



Home Learning: activities in addition to reading

'Reach for the Stars' – optional enrichment activities to enjoy with your child:

- ⇒ Challenge 1: Write a recount about something recent that has happened. It could be about an exciting adventure or what you did at the weekend. Don't forget to include how each part of the day made you feel.
- ⇒ Challenge 2: Draw different shapes and practise shading in one half, one third and one quarter. Is it possible to shade the same shape in all of the different fractions?
- ⇒ Challenge 3: In computing, we are making music digitally, so create some lyrics for a song or rap to go alongside your piece of music.
- ⇒ Challenge 4: Hunt around your house and sort each object into either a solid, liquid or gas. Remember that every object will have a state of matter.
- ⇒ Challenge 5: In art, we are creating pieces based on water. Create a piece of art which features water in it. You could make it by painting, colouring or even make it by using a collage of materials.
