




'Reach for the Stars' – optional enrichment activities to enjoy with your child:

⇒**Challenge 1:** As it's World Book Day, create a new front cover for your favourite book.

⇒**Challenge 2:** Write your own imaginative story where you are the main character!

⇒**Challenge 3:** We are learning about fact files in English, so choose a subject of your choice to create a fact file about. You can include pictures with captions too.

⇒Challenge 4: Measure your whole family using metres and centimetres and order everyone's heights.

⇒**Challenge 5:** Weigh ingredients using grams to cook or bake something delicious with an adult.

⇒**Challenge 6:** Make a junk modelled car with wheels that move to take part in our DT car racing day.
