




Reading every day: the power of 1:1 reading

The expectation is that every child reads at home (or is read to by an adult) every day.

Where it is such a key life skill, we feel this sits at the very top of our home learning priorities.

Reading 'High 5'

- Bring your reading record in every day.
- An adult will check these weekly.
- Once you have read five times (this does not have to be in the same week and weekends can be included) an adult will tick the 'High 5' reading chart and you will be given a pom pom for our class jar!
- When the jar is full of pom poms, our class will get time to celebrate our success together with a reading raffle activity!









Home Learning: activities in addition to reading

Home Learning: activities in addition to reading

'Reach for the Stars' – optional enrichment activities to enjoy with your child:

- ⇒ Challenge 1: Write an information text about a place that you know lots about. It could be somewhere you have been on holiday, a place where a relative lives or even Bournemouth! Write all the information that someone would need to know about this place.
- ⇒ Challenge 2: Research a famous explorer and make a poster all about them including interesting facts and what they explored.
- ⇒ Challenge 3: Create a script for you own puppet show that you could put on to family and friends at home.
- ⇒ Challenge 4: Practise telling the time by keeping a diary of a day and record the times that each event takes place throughout the day.
- ⇒ Challenge 5: Create a chart for some information (e.g. What is your favourite ice cream flavour?) and record the data in a tally chart, pictogram or block diagram.
- ⇒ Challenge 6: Make patters with shapes by positioning them differently with quarter, half and three-quarter turns.
- ⇒ Challenge 7: Create a picture that represents your Year 2 journey with your favourite moments and memories.
